Climbing on and off the coaches	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>Coaches will be on the main road- parents to closely supervise their children when boarding and departing off the coach.</li> <li>Parents, children and staff to watch their steps going on and off the coach.</li> <li>Be extra careful if carrying small children.</li> <li>Staff to support parents and children board safely</li> </ul>
Road Safety	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>Children to be holding the appropriate adults hand when crossing the road or waiting for the coach.</li> <li>First aid to be given where necessary.</li> </ul>
Slips, trips and falls	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>Practitioners to discuss keeping safe with the children the day before.</li> <li>First aid kit to be outside at all times.</li> <li>Staff, parents and children to wear appropriate footwear.</li> </ul>
Head injury	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>First aid trained staff.</li> <li>Cold compresses available at all times.</li> <li>Emergency contact information for all children who are with practitioners.</li> <li>Permission to seek professional medical assistance sought.</li> </ul>
Dangerous objects in and around the waiting area	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>All dangerous objects to be removed and thrown away safely.</li> <li>Practitioners to record any dangerous objects they find and report findings to management.</li> <li>Parents to supervise their children during waiting times.</li> </ul>
Dropping items from the storage onto feet/toes	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>Ensue you have a good grip of items when lifting them into the storage area.</li> <li>Be sure items are stored safely, so they do not drop out of the storage on arrival.</li> <li>Ensure only adults are near the storage area at all times. No children to be present.</li> </ul>
Lost Child	Children	<ul> <li>To do a head count of all the children before departing from nursery on the coach</li> <li>Count children before departing from the venue at the end of the trip</li> <li>Children to have a sticker with the manager's telephone number and nursery name on at all times.</li> <li>Parents and staff to have close supervision on the children at all times.</li> <li>Lost Children: Lost Child wristbands are available from Guest Services on entrance.</li> </ul>

		<ul> <li>Lost Children's make contact with any member of staff who will take them to LEGO City Guest Services as a reuniting point.</li> <li>Inform the manager your child is lost on 07930 380443</li> </ul>
Risk identification in the park	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>Take notice of the warning and advisory signs displayed around legoland</li> <li>Do not cross the safety barriers in place.</li> <li>Take notice of safety notices on trees, railings, fence etc. where relevant.</li> </ul>
Electric shock from electric fencing around	Children, parents and staff	Take notice of electric fence warning signs and keep out signs.
Strangers	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>Children to be supervised at all times by appropriate adult</li> <li>Adults to stay vigilant and observe people who may approach children.</li> </ul>
Critical incident	Children, parents and staff	<ul> <li>Telephone number of manager on all children</li> <li>Parents phone numbers held by more than one member of staff</li> <li>Adults to vacate to a safe hiding place as soon as safe to do so</li> <li>Adults to turn mobile phones on silent as to not draw attention to themselves</li> <li>Everyone to report to the coaches for a head count when the all areas are safe</li> </ul>

- For health and safety reasons we advise all parents and carer's to remain seated for the duration of the journey.
- We cannot take responsibility for lost of personal belongings i.e. Mobile phones. Cameras, toys, buggies, bags etc... please ensure you take all your belongings with you when departing from the coach.
